

## ST. FRANCIS DAYS CORNHOLE TOURNAMENT

All teams will play 3 random opponents in a round robin.

**1 (one) single game** will be played to the score of 21 with no bust rule applied.

After the round robin games have been completed, all teams will be seeded into 1(one) of 2(two) brackets. Bracket "A" will pay out 60% of the prize fund. Bracket "B" will pay out 40% of prize fund.

Once the brackets have been determined the tournament will be double elimination. Each team will play 1 (one) game. The winner will advance.

Members of the same team must be facing each other on the same side of the court at opposite boards. I.e. Both players on east side of boards, one throwing north, and one throwing south.

Players must play from their designated side the entire game.

Decision on who throws first will be determined by a coin flip. Team that wins can either choose playing position or first throw. Team that loses chooses playing position if winner of coin toss chooses to throw first.

Players may not step past the front of the board, also known as the foul line. If a player steps over the foul line, the bag that was thrown shall be removed from the playing surface immediately.

Bags that hit the ground and roll up onto the board do not count and must be removed from the playing surface immediately.

Scoring is on a cancellation basis, meaning if team A scores three bags on the board(one (1) point each), and team B scores one in the hole (three(3) points) and one on the board (one(1) point) team B scores one (1) point for the round.

Only bags that remain on the board or have gone into the hole, at the end of the round, whether pushed or thrown counts towards scoring.

If there are any questions on the rules, the judge's ruling will be final. American Cornhole Organization rules will be consulted if additional rules need to be applied.

Only the bags that are provided may be used in tournament play.
